

Great Opportunities with the Divine,

Reflections and Revelations... A New Season

Lord God, you showed yourself alive after the passion. You are the Son of the Living God. Lord, reveal Jesus to our hearts, minds, and spirits. Holy Spirit come and glorify and testify about our Savior Jesus Christ of Nazareth.

Father, you said today is a new day **the Lord has made, let us rejoice and be glad (Psalm 118:24)**. It is a new season. Are you walking in purpose? **The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand (Matthew 3:2)**, and time is short. Good deeds will not open the gates of Heaven and welcome you in. While the deeds are good, are they God's direction and purpose for your life? Have you sought the Holy Spirit before you undertake any particular task. While it may be a good thing, is it a God thing?

In **Luke 10:38:-42**, Jesus demonstrates what pleases him most...

³⁸ Now while Jesus and his disciples were on their way, it occurred that Jesus entered a certain village, and a woman named Martha received and welcomed Him into her house.

³⁹ And she had a sister named Mary, who seated herself at the Lord's feet and was listening to His teaching.

³⁹ But Martha [overly occupied and too busy] was distracted with much serving; and she came up to Him and said, Lord is it nothing to You that my sister has left me to serve alone? Tell her then to help me [to lend a hand and do her part along with me]!

⁴⁰ But the Lord replied to her by saying, Martha, Martha, you are anxious and troubled about many things:

⁴¹ There is need of only one or but a few things. Mary has chosen the good portion [that which is to her advantage], which shall not be taken away from her.

Are you waiting on the Lord God to guide your every step?



Jeremiah 1:5

Before I formed you in the womb I knew [and] approved of you [as My chosen instrument]. And before you were born I separated and set you apart, consecrating you; [and] I appointed you as a prophet to the nations.

He wants to do that. He wants to be part of everything, even the small things in your life.

Isaiah 64:4 states, For from the days of old no one has heard, nor has ear perceived, Nor has the eye seen a God besides You, Jehovah, Jesus Christ, Who works and acts in behalf of one who [gladly] waits for Him.

When you follow His direction, and wait expectantly, all things go smoothly and easy. When you jump ahead of the Lord, you bypass His Will, and while you may be successful, the journey may be hard and the victory may not last. The Lord confirms this.

In **Isaiah 55:9, He says, For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways. And My thoughts higher than your thoughts.** So, it behooves us to consult with the Holy Spirit on everything, even the smallest matter.

Be aware of the new season upon you, so you do not miss the spiritual promotion God has for you. He wants you to seek Him and to grow in your relationship with Him. Spend time with Him. Do not let distractions keep you from being with Him.

This spiritual promotion is not only at the personal level, but at the national level. The enemy is busy distracting everyone from what is truly important. He is trying to make people fearful of the Coronavirus instead of focusing on the Lord God's Will. The enemy is busy keeping people distracted with the Coronavirus, while he concocts more chaos, confusion, and destruction.

In **1 Peter 5:8**, the Lord states ...

Be sober [well-balanced and self-disciplined], be alert and cautious at all times. That the enemy, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion [fiercely hungry], seeking someone to devour.

There is a short window of time when the Lord God is calling you in to serve him to fulfill your life's purpose. If you choose to be a Martha and distract yourself doing good deeds, you may miss your calling. Be vigilant, spend time with God, listening, receiving instruction, and deepening your relationship with the King of Kings so you delight the Lord Your God and live, walk, and fulfill your life's purpose.

Here is a short prayer the Holy Spirit had me share:

Lord God, I repent for not putting You first in everything I do, from waking up every morning to going to bed every night. Forgive me Lord God. Wash me clean and burn away anything in me that does not glorify You. Let the Blood of Jesus saturate every cell, every system in my body, mind, and spirit. I know You will forgive me because right here and right now I forgive all those who have transgressed against me. I ask that You be merciful with them. I release them from any judgments I may have had against them. Lord, I now receive Your forgiveness, and request and receive exemption from judgment. Father, establish Yourself in me and in all I do today and going forward. Help me to always consult You on anything I undertake, even the smallest task. Help me to always choose You and Your Will. Fill me with an insatiable hunger for You, Lord Jesus, and ignite a new Holy Ghost fire in me and pour out a fresh new anointing taking me to higher and greater levels of service. Lord, I thank You for Your Grace, and that Your mercy endures forever. I love You Lord God and exalt Your name, and thank You for all You do, in Jesus name I pray.
