Jesus Yeshua's Supernatural Blood

The first man, Adam, was 'of blood'; 'dam' meaning Blood'; 'Adam' meaning 'man'. Jesus Yeshua came as the Son of Man, the second Adam, a new Blood. A new Blood for a new covenant. Jesus came to fulfill all righteousness (Matthew 3:15), and He came to *restore* all righteousness.

His sacrificed Blood has been invoked for healing, protection and favor. In these scientifically advanced times, the miracle Blood of Jesus has been analyzed and convicts us of its supernatural power and presence. Let's look at the application of Jesus' Blood in the Hebrew word for 'proclaim'.

Proclaim!

'Proclaim' in Hebrew is *qara* meaning to 'call', 'proclaim' or 'read'. There are three expressions, 3 C's, of 'proclaim' that reveal the power and purpose of proclaiming.

Creational

- ◆ "God called the light day and the darkness He called night." Genesis 1:5
- ◆ "God called the expanse [of sky] heaven." Genesis 1:8
- ◆ "God called the dry land earth, and the gathering of the waters He called seas." Genesis 1:10
- ◆ "And whatever the man called a living creature, that was its name."
 Genesis 2:19
- ◆ "She shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man."
 Genesis 2:23

Commission

◆ "I, even I, have spoken; indeed, I have called Cyrus; I have brought him, and will make his way successful." Isaiah 48:15

◆ "Listen to Me, O islands and coastlands, and pay attention, you peoples from far away. The Lord has called Me from the womb; from the body of My mother He has named Me." Isaiah 49:1

Call Forth ~ Summon

- ◆ "As the lion or the young lion growls over his prey, and though a large group of shepherds is called out against him..." Isaiah 31:4
- ◆ "She would not return to the king unless he delighted in her and she was summoned by name." Esther 2:14

Because life is in the blood, it holds the power of purification, sanctification, justification, and atonement. Blood, being life, is why it was said about Jesus that unless you "drink his blood, you have no life in you". (John 6:53)

The Miracle Blood of Jesus Yeshua

A most exciting gift of modern technology has been the ability to analyze the Miracle Blood of Jesus Yeshua as it has appeared in different places and circumstances. Regardless of these differences, the properties of the Miracle Blood of Jesus Yeshua are consistent. Let's look at some examples...

1. Ron Wyatt Discovers the Ark of the Covenant¹

The LORD anointed a humble Southern man to be His modern-day Indiana Jones. Ron Wyatt was an anesthesiology nurse that God directed to 'discover' several sacred biblical sites and artifacts. One of these discoveries was the Ark of the Covenant. The last time it is mentioned in the Bible, Jeremiah is hiding it from the invading Babylonians.²

Ron noticed blood on the mercy seat, the covering of the Ark. He took a sample of it and brought it to a lab in Israel to be analyzed. He did not reveal beforehand the source of the blood. They determined the following:

- It was human blood.
- ◆ The blood had only 24 chromosomes in it. (Every human being has 46 chromosomes.³) The blood had 23 chromosomes from the man's mother and one Y chromosome, which indicated he was a human male.
- ◆ All of his physical characteristics would have been determined by his mother's side through the autosomes.
- → His father's side was determined "not a human male".
- ◆ The blood was still alive.

When the lab technicians asked whose blood is this, Ron replied: "It's the blood of your Messiah."

³ "In humans, each cell normally contains 23 pairs of chromosomes, for a total of 46. Twenty-two of these pairs, called autosomes, look the same in both males and females. The 23rd pair, the sex chromosomes, differ between males and females. Females have two copies of the X chromosome, while males have one X and one Y chromosome." 2. The Eucharistic Host⁴

There have been several recorded cases of blood showing up on a Eucharistic host, often after it has been desecrated. This can include it falling on the floor or being placed outside of a sanctified container. The incidences of blood showing up in the host have occurred in different places around the world, from South America to Europe.⁵

The blood type is always AB, similar to the one found in the Host of Lanciano and in the Holy Shroud of Turin.

3. The Shroud of Turin⁶

The blood marks on the Shroud of Turin have been rigorously tested and analyzed. The wounds are all consistent with the accounts of how and where Jesus was beaten in His Passion, from the scourging by the Romans, the crown of thorns they mockingly placed upon His head, to the spear that was lunged into His side when He took His last breath.

According to the magazine Miłujcie sie!, "On October 5, 1999, in the presence of the Cardinal's representatives, scientist Dr. Ricardo Castañón Gómez took a sample of the bloody fragment and sent it to New York for analysis." One of these scientists was Dr. Frederic Zugiba, the well-known cardiologist and forensic pathologist. He determined that the analyzed substance was real flesh and blood containing human DNA. Zugiba testified that "the analyzed material is a fragment of the heart muscle found in the wall of the left ventricle close to the valves. This muscle is responsible for the contraction of the heart. It should be borne in mind that the left cardiac ventricle pumps blood to all parts of the body. The heart muscle is in an inflammatory condition and contains a large number of white blood cells. This indicates that the heart was alive at the time the sample was taken. It is my contention that the heart was alive, since white blood cells die outside a living organism. They require a living organism to sustain them. Thus, their presence indicates that the heart was alive when the sample was taken. What is more, these white blood cells had penetrated the tissue, which further indicates that the heart had been under severe stress, as if the owner had been beaten severely about the chest." ⁵ From Poland, 2013: "In February 2014, a tiny red fragment of the host was separated and put on a corporal. The Commission ordered to take samples in order to conduct the thorough tests by the relevant research institutes. After the investigations, the Department of Forensic Medicine stated: In the histopathological image, the fragments of tissue have been found containing the fragmented parts of the cross striated muscle. (...) The whole (...) is most similar to the heart muscle with alterations that often appear during the agony. The genetic researches indicate the human origin of the tissue."

Wound of a Roman Crucifixion⁷

- ♦ Nail Wounds through the ankles
- Scourging
- ◆ Lance wounds The wound corresponded precisely to a Roman lance. "But one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear, and immediately blood and water came out." John 19:34

Additional Blood Wounds

◆ Crown of Thorns blood wounds — The blood flows from the head down on to the face.

Summary of the Features of the Blood of Jesus

- ♦ It's alive. (Dried blood is not alive but His is.)
- ◆ Therefore able to get a chromosome count, which is taken from white blood cells.
- ◆ The chromosome count is 23 X and only 1 Y; a total of only 24 chromosomes. A normal human male has 46 chromosomes; 23 X and 23 Y.
- ♦ It is the blood of a human male.
- ◆ The human male has a human mother.
- ♦ The human male has no human father.
- ◆ In the Eucharistic Host: It is blood from human heart/cardiac tissue.
 Great trauma has been incurred.
- ◆ It is AB blood type, the "universal receiver"; meaning, it can receive any of the other human blood types, such as O, A or B positive or negative.

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I. The High Priest Empowers the Blood

# → Jesus the High Priest Presents the New Blood Covenant

- ◆ A priest performs covenant rituals and rites. When did Jesus do this? At the Last Supper when He instituted the New Covenant, transmuting the Passover (Seder) bread into His body and the Passover wine into His blood. His first miracle, the Wedding at Cana, He transmuted purification water into fine wine. He was the groom that saved the best wine for last. Now He is changing wine representing the old covenant, into the wine of the New Covenant.
  - ◆ The wine of the New Covenant is His Blood. It has proven to possess supernatural properties.
  - ♦ What does this mean for our relationship with Him?
  - → How is the High Priest of the New Covenant drawing you closer to God through His sacrifice?
- → Jesus is affirmed High Priest of the New Covenant
  - ◆ Hebrews 4:14-16 says: "Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. Let us then approach God's throne of grace with

confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need."

◆ "According to the order of Melchizedek." Hebrews 5:6, 6:20, 7:11,
7:15.

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"Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant,

II. The Priest Offers the New Wine

- ◆ The "best wine saved for last" is this wedding feast and the great harvest of souls that is at hand. The wine of our Lord as Prophet, Priest and King. "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser", says Jesus in John 15:1.
- ◆ Amos 9:13 declares the new harvest wine: "Behold, the days are coming," says the Lord, "When the plowman shall overtake the one who gathers the harvest, and the one who treads the grapes [shall overtake] him who sows the seed [for the harvest continues until planting time]; when the mountains will drip sweet wine and all the hills shall melt [that is, everything that was once barren will overflow with streams of blessing]."

III. The Blood of the Spotless Lamb is Offered Up

- → Jesus as High Priest <u>transmutes the wine into the Blood</u> of the New Covenant.
- ◆ Matthew 26:27 says: "And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you; for this is My blood of the [new and better] covenant, which [ratifies the agreement and] is

being poured out for many [as a substitutionary atonement] for the forgiveness of sins."

"He is clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God." Revelation 19:13

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IV. Proclaim the Power of the Blood

- ◆ I am made holy through His own Blood, according to Hebrews 13:12.
- → I am justified by His Blood, according to Romans 5:9.
- ◆ I am purified from all sin by the Blood of Jesus, according to 1 John 1:7.
- ◆ Now at this very moment in Christ Jesus, I who once was so very far away from God in Christ Jesus, have been brought near by the blood of Christ, according to Ephesians 2:13.
- ◆ I have redemption through His Blood and the forgiveness of sins, according to Ephesians 1:7.
- ◆ I am redeemed with the precious Blood of Jesus, according to 1 Peter 1:18-19.
- ◆ Lord Jesus, you have made me holy through Your own blood, according to Hebrews 13:12.
- ◆ Lord Jesus, You have freed me from sins by Your blood, according to Revelation 1:5.
- ◆ Lord Jesus, Your flesh is true food, and Your blood is true drink, according to John 6:55.
- ◆ Lord Jesus, help me to understand Your words from John 6:53: "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in yourselves." And John 6:54: "He who eats

My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day."

- ◆ I receive peace through the Lord's Blood shed on the Cross, according to Colossians 1:20.
- → Thank you Lord Jesus for Your blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many, according to Mark 14:24.
