"Vanity of vanities," says the Preacher.

"Vanity of vanities!

All [that is done without God's guidance]
is vanity [futile, meaningless—a wisp of smoke,
a vapor that vanishes, merely chasing the wind]."

Ecclesiastes 1:2 AMP

In Ecclesiastes, King Solomon, "son of David", is reflecting on the ultimate futility and temporal value of human wisdom and endeavors based upon them. This may seem like a downer of a book in the Sacred Scriptures, but it reminds us of the fleeting quality of human actions that are not part of God's plan and Will.

"I, the Preacher, have been king over Israel in Jerusalem.

I have seen all the works which have been done under the sun, and behold, all is vanity, a futile grasping and chasing after the wind."

I take hold of Hebrews 11:16, "But now they desire a better homeland, a heavenly one." This does not mean I am not honoring and appreciative of the life You have given me here on earth. It does mean that I recognize that the ultimate goal and purpose of my life here is to come into union with You in "a better homeland." And that all that I shall do in this life is to prepare me to be in fellowship with You and Christ Jesus in Your heavenly home.

Truly in this regard, I recognize that the most important legacy I could leave on this earth is a legacy of love. ### I Repent

- ✦ Heavenly Father, I repent for all the times and ways I lost my focus on You, I got swept up in the activities, demands and desires of this world, and forgot or neglected to keep You and Your Will for my life as the centerpiece and compass.
- ◆ I repent for all the times and ways I was not kind, compassionate, considerate, forgiving, understanding of other people, of other people's inner state; allowing my own agenda, filters, prejudices and resentments to cloud my heart and keep me from loving as Jesus loves; as He called me to love others.
- ◆ I repent for all the vanities I have held and pursued material and financial vanities, ego and status vanities, career and vocational vanities, even spiritual vanities.

#### Love Leads Me to Eternal Life

- ◆ Lord God Heavenly Father, as Divine Love Incarnate, Jesus demonstrated the qualities and virtues of True Love, a love that comes from your own heart, a love that serves others as an expression of the love I have for You and Your Son Jesus Yeshua.
- → John 3:16 shares this beautiful promise: "For God so loved the world, that He gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."
- ◆ This passage teaches me that sacrificial love, unselfish love, is a pathway to eternal life. This sacrificial and unselfish love are a part of a lasting legacy of love; that lives on to encourage, to uplift, to heal and to bless others — even those we have never known and will never personally know us.

- ◆ Because when I can love, when I choose to love and commit to love as Jesus does, He works through me to touch others; as 1 John 4:4 describes: "He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world." Jesus in me reaches out to love others. They can literally experience the love of Jesus through me.
- ✦ Heavenly Father, I commit to choosing every day to love as Christ Jesus does. He sees through people's flaws and annoyances. He sees their hearts as a Father sees his vulnerable and imperfect child. He chooses to love them as Your child. I commit to leaving behind my own ego to love others as You love them, as Jesus loves them. Help me Father God, to do so. I pray in Jesus' name.
- ◆ 2 Timothy 2:11-12 confirms that as I emulate Jesus, so may I join him in eternal life: "If we died with him, we will also live with him; if we endure, we will also reign with him."
- ◆ Titus 1:2 speaks of this eternal life: "In the hope of eternal life that God, who does not lie, promised before time began." "Promised before time began" is so profound and tells me that it has always been Your plan that I should share in eternal life with You and Your Son.
- → Help me Father God, to order my life and my priorities, to leave a legacy of love on the way to eternal life with You and Christ Jesus. Help me to deny myself, and my own desires and insistences. Help me to empty of my sins, flaws and transgressions through self-examination, repentance and atonement. Reveal to me atonement that fully reconciles me to Your Heart.

I Shall Work For Food That Endures

◆ Dear Heavenly Father, Jesus teaches us to focus on what truly matters for eternal life, what brings an enduring legacy of Love, Divine Love.

- ◆ In John 6:27 Jesus exhorts: "Do not work for the food that perishes but for the food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you. For on him God the Father has set his seal." Lord God, please give me this food for eternal life. Help me to always eat of it worthily, with a clean heart.
- ◆ For Your Word in Matthew 5:8 declares: "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God." I want to see You Abba! I want to see Your Son, Lord Jesus! Make of me a clean, pure heart. Remove the bramble, the sticks and stones, the pebbles and debris in my heart. In Jesus' name, remove them now.

### The Agency of Love Is the Holy Spirit

- ◆ Dear Father God, when the Holy Spirit descended on the Disciples at Pentecost, they were of "one accord." They were transformed. Their hearts were transformed. Their character was transformed. They went from infighting and jostling for positions, renouncing their association with Christ Jesus, to a supernatural boldness and courage, united in Holy Love. This demonstrates the agency of the Holy Spirit for love.
- ◆ Lord God Abba, pour out Your Holy Spirit into my heart, as the agency for your Love, to be the Holy Fire of Your Love that fills and becomes my own heart. This is not a flawed or codependent or lustful human love; but a Holy Love that Your Son lived and demonstrated as my spiritual destiny.
- ◆ Indeed it is a bold and courageous love. It is an unselfish love. It is a compassionate and forgiving love. It is a love that serves others through "acts of mercy." It is a love that serves Christ in others, as Your Word in Matthew 25:35 expresses: "I was hungry and you gave me something to eat."

YOUR Love

- ◆ Dear Heavenly Father, Your version of love is so beyond what we humans have come to believe and know is love; the sadly limited kind of love that we give in this fallen world. But YOUR love IS available for us to possess. This is THE GREATEST gift that Jesus gave us, to love as He has loved us; as Jesus exhorted in John 13:34: "This I tell you, love one another as I have loved you."
- ♦ It is possessing the Heart of God in loving others. It is an unselfish love.
 It is loving the way that You love, an unconditional and pure love with no personal agendas.
- ♦ It is so important that Your Word says it is the supreme of all virtues. 1 Corinthians 13:13 proclaims: "And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love." This surely confirms that a legacy of love is the supreme legacy a person can leave.
- ◆ This love contains a radical kindness. Kindness is such an important godly virtue that the Hebrew language has a special word for it, chesed, lovingkindness. Help me, Heavenly Father, to live in this virtue of chesed, lovingkindness. For it is very hard for the ego to co-exist with lovingkindness.
- → Jesus forgave alot of bad behavior and even cruelties. Yoke me with His heart Heavenly Father, as I relinquish and empty out all that is not of You and for You in my own heart.
- → Help me Abba Father, to live in and leave a legacy of Your love, through my actions, deeds, words and way of being. Let it be a demonstrated legacy of the gift of Your Son Jesus Christ, given for all of humanity.
