Refreshing Ourself in the Lord is Essential

God our Creator Father exists in the stillness. He is the "peace that passes all understanding." He is the Shalom, the wholeness and peace, that is at the core of our existence, in which our soul was birthed.

So it is essential that we build time into our lives, even our daily schedule, to "Be still and know that I AM God." (Psalm 46:10) That is, to experience and connect with God in the stillness. This is essential in an overload world where technology consumes our attention, time and energy.

The Law of the Sabbath - Holy Rest

The 4th Commandment gives us the Law of honoring the Sabbath, which is the spiritual law of rest, renewal and refreshment in the Lord of Shalom. The derivation of Sabbath or Shabbath, comes from "to cease". To cease activity. To "Be still and know that I AM God."

The purpose of Sabbath is to renew our strength and spirit, to restore and refresh our soul, to rejuvenate our body. The purpose of this law of rest is to <u>re-attune us</u> to our Creator who exists in the eternal Rest, the eternal Shalom-peace that passeth understanding; that surpasses our mind understanding, calculations and busyness.

Dear Heavenly Father, We Pray....

For your people to be refreshed in You, that their souls be restored and that You renew their strength — body, mind and soul.

Pour Your Shalom Across Our Lands

- ◆ Dear Heavenly Father, we ask You to pour out your Shalom your peace that passes ALL understanding, across our lands, across America and all her peoples. Cover us and fill us with your healing, restorative Shalom now.
- ◆ I pray Psalm 16:8-11 over America: Lord God, we set the Lord always before America; because You are at our right hand, we shall not be shaken. Therefore our hearts are glad, and our whole being rejoices; our flesh also dwells secure. For You will not abandon our souls to Sheol, or let your holy one see corruption. You make known to us the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore. Thank you Heavenly Father for your Hand of Shalom over America!

Sabbath Rest Leads to Eternal Rest

- ◆ Dear Heavenly Father, Your Word makes it clear that if we do not believe in Your Word (and Your Laws ARE Your Word), we are not able to enter into eternal rest with You. So if we cannot or will not truly honor the Sabbath and disconnect from the secular world, how we can expect to enter into eternal rest with You?
- ◆ For Hebrews 3:18-19 exclaims: "And to whom did God swear that they would never enter his rest if not to those who disobeyed? So we see that they were not able to enter, because of their unbelief."
- ◆ So Lord God, we ask You to convict your sons and daughters of the value and purpose of taking true rest, allowing You to be the centerpiece of their time of rest, creating space for silence and stillness to hear from You, to attune to You in the silence, to enable them to hear YOUR voice over all the clutter and clamor of this world.

Beckon People to Peace

◆ Dear Heavenly Father, we pray that our brethren in the Faith will discover and experience that resting in your peace and stillness allows You to bring victories and resolution to problems.

- ◆ Quiet us by your love, Heavenly Father God, according to Zephaniah 3:17. Pour out your Shalom into our heart, mind, body and soul.

Call Them To Your Rest

- ◆ Dear Heavenly Father, call your people to your rest. Convict them of the treasures that are found in resting in You.
- ◆ We release Matthew 11:28 as an exhortation and invitation, that the souls coming into your Kingdom will hear this with their hearts and spiritual ears: "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."
- ◆ Lord God, convict your sons and daughters that rest and stillness actually strengthen us, both spiritually and physically; as Isaiah 30:15 consoles: "In repentance and rest is your salvation, in quietness and trust is your strength."

Restore Our Souls

- ◆ Dear Heavenly Father, it's hard to always remember to take time out, quiet time, that You may enter in to restore my soul. I give over to You any compulsions, bad habits and blockages I may have, that stand in the way of my soul being refreshed in You. And I pray this for my brethren in the Faith.
- ◆ I take hold of Jeremiah 31:25 which says: "For I will satisfy the weary soul, and every languishing soul I will replenish." Lord God, I ask You to

satisfy all the weary souls in our country, replenish them with your love and Shalom.

- ◆ Lord God, I yield to your stillness and proclaim Psalm 23:3, that You restore my soul. You lead me in paths of righteousness for Your name's sake. I surrender to your paths of righteousness for my life, instead of always trying to steer my own ship. Restore the souls of your people Lord God! Restore their souls!
- ◆ Lord God Abba, I commit to making moments in my days to hear from You, sitting in stillness and waiting on You, for Isaiah 40:31 promises: "But they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint."
- ✦ Heavenly Father, please reveal to me the depths of the meaning of Psalm 19:7: "The law of the Lord is perfect, reviving the soul; the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple."
