Power in the Stillness

Let Us Pray Together...

Dear Heavenly Father, I come before You as your Intercessor Son/ Daughter, committing to taking this time to rest in You in the gap, for our beloved country America and for my own rejuvenation. Your power and glory come from Your stillness. We were born from Your stillness. It is our origins and our destination. It is a spiritual operating system.

I commit to submitting my mind, will, thoughts, emotions, agendas, fears, worries, attachments, mental habits, to Your holy stillness. I commit to yielding to Your stillness, resting in You, in this season of emptying out the old to receive the new wine of the Risen Lord Jesus Christ Yeshua.

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## The Power of Our Spirits Enjoined With God in Stillness

- ◆ Heavenly Father, through Your Son, Jesus Christ Yeshua and His Passion Gift which I have gratefully received, *“Greater is He who is in me that he (the adversary) who is in the world.”* Throughout Your Word You tell us that we are spiritually stronger when we are united with one another in Your Spirit.
- ◆ As 1 Corinthians 1:10 says: *“I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and the same judgment.”* Heavenly Father, we unite in our submission to You in stillness; preparing our hearts in this season to receive our Resurrected Lord Jesus Christ.
- ◆ So we embrace this time of unified stillness in You; as Psalm 46:10 exhorts us: *“Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!”* So in our stillness, YOU shall do Your works to be exalted and honored on earth and in our America. Thank you Heavenly Father!
- ◆ Psalm 133:1 declares: *“Behold, how good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell in unity!”* Oh Heavenly Father God, surely our spirits enjoy a unity as we share in resting in Your stillness, which brings us to commune with You in the depths of our hearts.
- ◆ Matthew 11:28 invites us: *“Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and **I will give you rest.**”* Lord Jesus Christ, I come to You in this holy season to rest in You, to receive rest **in** You. Fill me with Your Shalom, the Peace of God that surpasses all human understanding and comprehension. Rejuvenate my soul and my body as I rest in the stillness of the Lord God Most High. Thank you Lord Jesus Christ.
- ◆ Heavenly Father, just as the Apostles *“were all together in one place”* in Acts 2:1, we meet together in the stillness these coming days and weeks, to bring unity in the spirit. I ask You to pour out Your Holy Spirit into us more deeply, that we are infilled with a deeper Love of God, with

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a deeper peace of God, His Shalom; that we are filled with a deeper Wisdom of God; to always know and walk in Your ways and Holy Will.

## Renew Our Strength

- ◆ Dear Heavenly Father, You know how each of us needs to be renewed and refreshed, restored and rejuvenated in our mind, heart, body and soul. Pour out Your Spirit into us as we rest in Your stillness; to bring us refreshment, to purify our mind and ego, to take us to greater strength and heights as Your righteous Intercessors. Thank you Lord God, for renewing our strength and refreshing our spirits.
- ◆ The more purified and sanctified we are; the more authority and strength we have in battle against forces of darkness; the more effective we are in taking back domain for the Kingdom of God. For Isaiah 40:31 declares and we take hold of this promise: *“But they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be weary; they shall walk and not faint.”*
- ◆ I proclaim the Psalm of David, Psalm 23:1-3 that You Lord God are *my shepherd; I shall not want. You make me lie down in green pastures. You lead me beside still waters. You restore my soul.*
- ◆ Thank you Heavenly Father, for leading me into deeper stillness with You in this season; for helping me to leave the distractions of this world behind and drop into a deeper rest in You than I have ever experienced before. Thank you for restoring my soul.

## The Power of Stillness

- ◆ Heavenly Father, I commit to submitting to Your stillness in this season, to truly dropping into a deeper silence to be refilled by You and with You.
- ◆ As Psalm 37:7 exhorts: *“Be still before the Lord and **wait patiently for him**; fret not yourself over the one who prospers in his way, over the man who carries out evil devices!”* Heavenly Father, I commit to waiting

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patiently for You in the stillness, without worldly distractions competing for my attention.

- ◆ Heavenly Father, we take hold of Your spiritual principle and way, that You will fight for us as we are resting in Your stillness. As Exodus 14:13-14 tells us: *“And Moses said to the people, ‘Fear not, stand firm, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will work for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall never see again. **The Lord will fight for you, and you have only to be silent.**”* What a promise Lord God! I commit to submitting my mind and ego to You to rest in Your stillness, so that You will fight for me. What a relief! Thank you Lord God!
- ◆ Indeed Isaiah 30:15 instructs: *“For thus said the Lord God, the Holy One of Israel, ‘In returning and **rest you shall be saved; in quietness and in trust shall be your strength.**”*
- ◆ Isaiah 30:15 continues with a warning: *“But you were unwilling.”* Lord God, I truly repent for all the times You invited me into Your holy stillness and I was unwilling or failed in my resolution to do so. For when I allowed the trivialities and distractions of this world take precedence over communing with You in Your stillness.
- ◆ Thank you Heavenly Father, for Your promises in Isaiah 30:18, which I take hold of now: *“Therefore the Lord waits to be gracious to you, and therefore He exalts himself to show mercy to you. For the Lord is a God of justice; **blessed are all those who wait for him.**”* I commit to waiting on You in the rest of Your stillness, Lord God!
- ◆ Heavenly Father, Your Word in Colossians 3:15 teaches us that through the peace of Christ in our hearts, we are united in spirit: *“And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.”*
- ◆ As we are united in peace and spirit, Your power works through us to bring Thy Kingdom Come, Thy Will Be Done on earth as it is in Heaven.
